#### SCHOLARSHIPS, GRANTS, AND AWARDS

Scholarships, awards, and other financial aid are given to full-time students only. Tuition discounts received through awards will be automatically applied the following semester.

- Pastor’s Scholarship – Anyone serving as a church pastor will receive a scholarship covering 50% of their tuition.
- Church/Pastoral Community Outreach Grant – Members in good standing of either a church that financially supports ETS, or a church pastored by

an ETS professor, may apply for the Community Outreach Grant which covers 20% of tuition.

- Hispanic Ministries Scholarship – Students involved in Hispanic ministries may be eligible for an ETS scholarship. Approval and amount will be determined by the Scholarship Committee based on the student’s application. This scholarship cannot be used in conjunction with any of the above scholarships.
- The John Knox Honors Prize – The highest honor bestowed by the Seminary, this award recognizes the recipients as exemplary in their academic, ministerial, and personal achievements. The recipient of this award receives a full tuition credit.
- Honors Scholar Award – Honoring outstanding academic merit, this award gives tribute to the student who has earned the highest academic grade point average in their program. The recipient of this award receives a 20% credit toward tuition.
- Hardship Loans – These are given per the discretion of Scholarship Committee. An application and personal interview is required.

#### PAYMENTS

- All tuition and fees are due before the semester begins. Students depending on financial support from churches, organizations, individuals, etc., should therefore collect all funds prior to the beginning of the semester.
- Payment plans are available to some students with the approval of the Admissions Committee.
- Students will not be permitted to register for a new semester, graduate, or receive transcripts unless all financial obligations to the seminary have been settled.
